FREE TAX PREPARATION!



The Yadkin County Public Library, in partnership with Yadkin Christian Ministries, will be providing free tax preparation through the IRS's Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) and Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE) programs. The mission of these programs is to provide free basic tax return preparation for low-to moderate income taxpayers, elderly taxpayers and taxpayers with disabilities, limited English proficiency or military. To qualify, families must have an income of \$51,000 or less and need assistance with preparing tax returns.

Free tax preparation will be held at the Yadkin County Public Library, on a first come, first served basis, beginning on Wednesday, February 5, 2014 and Thursday, February 6, 2014 from 9:00 am – 12:00 pm and will continue each Wednesday and Thursday through April 10, 2014.

Free tax preparation will be offered in Jonesville at the Yadkin Valley Senior Center on Tuesdays from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm, **by appointment only**. Free tax preparation is also available at the East Bend Public Library on Thursdays from 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm and Saturdays from 9:00 am – 11:00 am, **by appointment only**.
